Rate G1544 — Single Phase/Military Service Rate Effective date – April 1, 2024

Applicability

This rate is applicable for all single-phase accounts that are bona fide residential properties with only one electric meter, and the member of record is presently serving in the National Guard or military reserve unit. This rate is applicable only when a call to duty creates a non-military career interruption. The rate will be effective only while the member is listed as active duty, and their account status is current. If the installation of motors requires more than 260 amperes starting current, prior approval from the Cooperative is necessary. Members who choose this rate must subscribe to electric distribution and energy services. They must also comply with the bylaws approved by the cooperative membership and all the rules and regulations adopted by its Board of Directors.

Power Cost Adjustment (PCA)

The PCA is a charge that may be added to or subtracted from the unit cost for every kilowatthour used to account for fluctuations in the cost of wholesale power.

Distribution Cost Adjustment (DCA)

The DCA is a charge that may be added to or subtracted from the unit cost for every kilowatthour used to meet yearly board-approved financial goals.

Minimum Monthly Charge

The minimum monthly charge shall be \$30.75 for members requiring a transformer capacity of 25 KVA or less. For members needing more than 25 KVA transformer capacity, the minimum monthly charge will equal the transformer's KVA rating. However, the Cooperative reserves the right to adjust the minimum charge to ensure adequate compensation for its investment in distribution facilities.

Taxes

The Cooperative will add the applicable tax imposed by the Illinois Public Utilities Revenue Act to the monthly billing statement. Additional taxes imposed by other taxing authorities will also be added when appropriate.

Terms of Payment

The abovementioned charges are to be paid in full by the due date. If payment is not made on the current monthly bill by the due date, a late fee of 5% will be added. The service may be disconnected without further notice if the unpaid balance remains unpaid by the monthly assigned cut-off date. If you cannot make payment in full, please contact the cooperative to discuss payment options.
