Availability

The following rate applies to developers, owners, and operators of electric generating facilities and entities involved in electricity production, either fully or partially within the Cooperative's service area and not utilizing the Cooperative's distribution facilities. This rate will be the default option if no contract exists with the Cooperative.

Power Cost Adjustment (PCA)

The PCA, also known as the "True Up," is a charge that will be added or subtracted from the unit cost of every kilowatt-hour used to adjust for changes in the cost of wholesale power. This charge will be calculated based on the costs at the member's delivery point.

Deposit

Before commencing service, a cash deposit, or a suitable guarantee in the form of an irrevocable letter of credit from an acceptable financial institution or a surety bond, equivalent to approximately 2.5 times the peak monthly bill, will be required. The deposit will be reassessed every year on January 1st to determine if any changes in the deposit amount are warranted

Taxes

The Cooperative will add the applicable tax imposed by the Illinois Public Utilities Revenue Act to the monthly billing statement. Additional taxes imposed by other taxing authorities will also be added when appropriate.

Terms of Payment

The charges mentioned above are net. If payment is not made by the net due date, gross charges (which are ten percent higher than the net charges) shall apply. The service may be disconnected without further notice if the gross charges are still unpaid by the cut-off date assigned each month.
